

AGREEMENT

This agreement is made this day, 17th November 2020, by and between the Director Italian Embassy Cultural Centre, 50-E, Chandragupta Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi-110021, hereafter referred to as the 'Centre', and Ms. Myna Mukherjee resident of C33-A JVTS Garden, Chattarpur Extension, New Delhi-110076, Passport n Z2042260, PAN n BPCPM6345A, Phone n. 9873061430, hereinafter referred to as the 'Producer'.

Whereas, the Producer proposes to the Italian Embassy Cultural Centre New Delhi at 50-E Chandragupta Marg Chanakyapuri, New Delhi 110021 to participate at the I-View World Human Rights Film Festival, Dec 10-20, 2020 with Italian films ;

Whereas, the Centre receives the proposal favorably and both the parties agree to as under:


- 1 The Centre agrees to pay the estimated amount of Indian Rupees 2,50,000.00 (Rupees two lakh fifty thousand) towards the cost for video editing for trailers for Italian films, post production, PR Marketing special press release and press drive, Social Media Campaign, OTT streaming, one or two panel conversations and other expenses related to the participation of Italian films in the I-View World Human Rights Film Festival to be held from 10th to 20th December 2020
- 2 The amount is all inclusive and all the relevant taxes, duties, payments to local and government bodies as may be due or become due in connection with the above production shall be directly paid by the Producer. The Centre is absolved off any such dues and claims and bears no responsibility. Any other authorizations or permissions etc. as may be required from the local authorities shall be procured directly by the Producer.
- 3 The amount of Rs 2,50,000 shall be paid in two instalments of Rs. 1,25,000 each, one on approval and signing of the contract and the second instalment after the initiation of the festival in December 2020.
- 4 Neither Party shall be entitled to assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations arising under this Agreement to any third party without the prior written consent of the other Party.
- 5 In the event of any controversy that may arise in connection with the present Agreement, such a controversy shall be resolved through amicable settlement.

This agreement consisting of 5 articles is drawn in two originals one for the Centre and one for the Producer.
