



AGREEMENT between:

Italian Embassy Cultural Centre New Delhi, situated at 50-E, Chandragupta Marg, Chanakyapuri, New Delhi-110021 India, represented by its Director Andrea Baldi, hereinafter referred to as IIC

and

Mr. Murtaza Ali Khan, resident of H.No: 262, First Floor, Hauz Rani, Malviya Nagar, New Delhi - 110017, hereinafter referred to as **Mr. Murtaza**,

It is hereby agreed as follows:

Art.1 Mr. Murtaza agrees to present one documentary and six movies by Pier Paolo Pasolini in connection with the event "Pier Paolo Pasolini Retrospective" at the India Habitat Centre, in the period of November 02-09, 2022 organized by the Italian Embassy Cultural Centre in collaboration with India Habitat Centre. Mr. Murtaza shall introduce each film with a brief five-minute presentation.

1.1 Mr Murtaza agrees to undertake the activity to talk about the importance of Pasolini's work and introduce the following films to the audience with a five-minute presentation:

- 02/11/2022: Sana'a Walls, Accattone
- 05/11/2022: The Hawks and the Sparrows
- 06/11/2022: The Gospel According to Saint Matthew
- 07/11/2022: The Decameron
- 08/11/2022: The Tales of Canterbury
- 09/11/2022: The flower of the one thousand and one nights

Art.2 Mr Murtaza also agrees to take part in the recording of a discussion with Mr Nico Pstiaidis regarding the importance of Pasolini's work. The aforementioned talk shall be shared online on the IIC social media channels.

Art.3 The IIC agrees to pay an all-inclusive amount of ₹ 70000 (Rupees seventy thousand only) to Mr. Murtaza for the above service. The amount will be paid by NEFT transfer, as per bank details provided by Mr.Murtaza.

3.1 The amount is all inclusive and all the relevant taxes, duties, payments to local and government bodies as may be due or become due in connection with the above service shall be directly paid by Mr. Murtaza. The IIC is absolved off any such dues and claims and bears no responsibility. Any other authorizations or permissions etc., if needed for the service, as may be required from the local authorities shall be procured directly by Mr. Murtaza.

Art. 4 Both parties give their consent to the publication of the beneficiary details and amount of the present Agreement on the official website of IIC in accordance with the Law of transparent administration of public entities (Dlgs. 33/2013).

Art. 5 Neither Party shall be entitled to assign or transfer any of its rights or obligations arising under this Agreement to any third party without the prior written consent of the other Party.


Art. 6 In the event of any controversy that may arise in connection with the present Agreement, such a controversy shall be resolved through amicable mutual settlement.
